The following are the dates applicable for admission to First Year.

The school will commence accepting applications for admission on	1st.October 2020
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	21stOctober 2020
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	4th November 2020
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	18th November 2020

Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.
